Transfer credits must be earned in a regionally accredited institution. Graduate-level course work taken elsewhere is not automatically applicable to the Health Psychology doctoral degree program at ECU. All requests for transfer credit must be made to the Program Director in writing, not later than the end of the second semester of study. The request must include copies of transcripts listing the course(s) and a copy of the syllabus used in the course. Those entering with graduate transfer credit typically have a shorter time to completion (less than 5 years).

Note: Our program requires full-time, on-campus study (i.e., no distance education options). Part-time study is only allowed for those who have completed all but dissertation. **All of our doctoral students receive funded graduate assistantships (GA) during their first four years of on-campus study. In addition to the GA stipend, students with GAs also receive a tuition remission (resident), full subsidy for health insurance, and an out-of-state tuition waiver for year 1.** University fees listed above are not waived. Students with qualifying GAs during the academic year (Fall & Spring) are eligible for tuition remission and health insurance subsidy for summer session regardless of whether they hold a GA during summer; however, summer funding is not guaranteed. Financial aid, grants, loans, and fellowships are also available to students who are eligible.
